## Diabetes Australia-NSW

**We aim to make a positive difference to the lives of people living with and at risk of diabetes.**

### Australians helping Australians

For more than 70 years, we have helped Australians with and at risk of diabetes by working to reduce its impact on their lives. Diabetes is the fastest growing chronic disease in Australia and around the world. As a non-profit, non-government organisation, our mission to improve health and enhance lives is enabled by members' funds and support from the community.

All funds raised are spent on research, education, awareness and advocacy programs.

### Search for a Cure

There is currently no cure for diabetes. Type 1 diabetes is an autoimmune disease which occurs when the body does not produce insulin. Without a lifetime of daily insulin injections, the person with type 1 diabetes will die. Type 2 diabetes is a metabolic disease, where the body does not produce enough insulin or doesn't use it properly. Type 2 diabetes can be linked to lifestyle factors including obesity and can be prevented in many cases. About 1,000,000 Australians are diagnosed with diabetes. However, for every one diagnosed, another is undiagnosed. In addition, an estimated 2.1 million Australians are at risk of diabetes.

### We make life easy for people

We provide personalised and practical assistance to benefit people with diabetes, their families and their carers; and to benefit people at risk of diabetes. Our Call Centre in NSW receives around 600 telephone calls a day, from concerned teachers, worried parents, the elderly, non-English speaking Australians and people who are confused and frightened about the burden of a lifetime struggling to deal with diabetes. We administer the government's National Diabetes Services Scheme which provides subsidised products to Australians who have diabetes.

### We are optimistic and upbeat

One of the problems characterising diabetes is that to live well, a person must adopt a lifetime commitment to managing their disease. For people with type 1 diabetes, this means injections every day of their lives, closely watching their diet and coping with the threat of complications... blindness, kidney failure, loss of limbs, heart disease and stroke. Diabetes is psychologically, physically and emotionally draining. It can fill the young with indignation and resentment. It can build walls of loneliness around the elderly. For these reasons, Diabetes Australia-NSW fully appreciates the need to maintain a positive and optimistic outlook on life. Ever since the invention of insulin, people with type 1 diabetes have been waiting and hoping for the cure that will change their lives. People with type 2 diabetes are also at risk of complications and need to manage their lifestyle and medications which may also include insulin. While every new medical development keeps hope alive, we constantly encourage people that they can lead long, fulfilling and rewarding lives by maintaining a healthy lifestyle and a positive attitude.

### We empower and enable people

A vital part of our work is reminding people with diabetes they are part of a team. This team includes their GP, Endocrinologist, Dietitian, Educator and Diabetes Australia-NSW. The team provides important information and support in relation to health, diet, exercise, managing blood glucose levels and advocacy.

The most important member of the team is the person with diabetes. This is especially important in the case of children, who need to be given every chance to learn, understand and live well with diabetes.
