Format

There are two competitions; Registered and Social.
 Each competition is one round, shotgun start, over 18 holes.

Registered Competition

Golfer must supply (on the Entry Form) a current verified AGU/WGA handicap, Golf Club and Golf Link number.

Maximum handicaps – Women 45 and Men 27

Higher handicaps will be lowered

Stableford Scoring applies. Returned completed cards must include Stableford pts and totals

If after entry your handicap has changed you must bring verification and notify Sport Venue Control at check in

Social Competition

Is a Scratch event (no handicap required)

Golfers may enter only one Competition. Best card is winner.
 The Individual and Team events are run concurrently.

Regulations

Registered (Boonie Doon) is a NON cart event.
 Foursomes on a tee must include only 2 from the same organisation.
 Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.
 If scores are tied the AGU countback system is applied.

An Individual may represent only ONE Organisation in the Games. Entry is NOT limited to employees.

Rules

The Royal and Ancient Rules of Golf apply

Corporate Team

Corporate Team consists of any 4 persons men, women or both.
 All team members must represent the same organisation.

Dress

Golf Dress code applies. Contact each club for details.
 Team result is the aggregate of the best 3 of 4 cards

Sport Venue Control Location – inside club house at each venue.
 Venue may change.

Entrants must report to Sport Venue Control at least 30mins before their shotgun time. Failure to do so may result in a forfeit. At this time your Games ID will be checked and you will receive your score card. You must also, if asked, show personal photo ID.

Entry Fee

\$120 per participant including GST
 Entry includes (one round) 18 holes and lunch or dinner after the round

Entry Deadlines

Guaranteed Entry Deadline February 4

Only complete Entries with payment are guaranteed

Final Entry Deadline February 18

Entries received after the Guaranteed Entry Deadline are taken on a "first come" basis

Replacement or Changes Deadline After March 4 replacements and changes will be at the discretion of the Games and subject to a \$25 fee per change.

Withdrawals and Refunds Deadline Before March 4 refunds are minus \$25 per person. After March 4 no refund. Withdrawals must be in writing.

Start Times & Draws

A preferred start time may be requested on the Entry Form but is not guaranteed. The Games will notify the team Captain/individual if the requested Start Time is not possible.

Your assigned Golf shotgun is on your Games ID

Unofficial Draws with start times are available from the Games website ONE week before the Games. Official Draws are only available from a Games SuperCentre open from Monday March 15 to Sunday March 21.
